

Luke's Place Student Internship Programme

Luke's Place will be awarding Internships in its Student Leadership Programme for the 2020-2021 academic year to students wanting to engage in the development of their faith and leadership skills and to obtain valuable hands-on experience in a variety of placement opportunities with Luke's Place and St. Luke's Worshipping Community.

The Programme:

Successful applicants will commit themselves to the following components of the programme:

- 1. Biweekly (6 per term) faith formation meetings led by the Director of Mission and others of Luke's Place with St. Luke's Worshipping Community.
- 2. Leadership Development Sessions led by a variety of expert facilitators and covering topics such as Leadership Styles, Communication, Conflict Resolution, Spirituality and Social Justice.
- 3. Community Placement of approximately 2 hours per week. Community placement to be determined based on the strengths and interests of the candidates. Options include:
 - Within Luke's Place / St. Luke's Worshipping Community: Campus Ministry, Youth Ministry, Chaplaincy Work, Children's Ministry, Event Planning, Social media and Communications, Music Leadership.
 - b. Placements with one of our partner organizations serving those who are homeless or in need in our neighbourhood.

Interns are expected to worship regularly with St. Luke's Worshipping Community and to be a visible part of our community and our campus ministry (Luke's Place). Successful applicants will be required to provide police record checks.

The Total Time Commitment: Expected to average 3-4 hours per week during the academic term. Interns report to the Director of Mission.

The Application and Placement Process:

- 1. Download the application form, complete and return to Luke's Place by email to adelemiles@diohuron.org. We encourage applicants to apply as soon as possible. Applicants must be post-secondary students, ages 17-30.
- 2. Selection of successful applicants will begin in May 2020. Interviews will be arranged, selections made, and successful applicants will meet with the Director of Mission to learn more about the programme, discern their gifts and passions and discuss placement opportunities.
- 3. Interns are expected to arrive in London by September 1st 2020 for orientation and participation in Luke's Place 'Welcome to the Neighbourhood' activities.
- 4. Placements and other components of the programme will commence in September 2020.
- 5. Interns will receive an honorarium of \$500 per semester (\$1000 total) for their acceptance into and successful participation in this programme.

Luke's Place is a new and growing ministry in the Deanery of London within the Anglican Diocese of Huron. We are located at 1204 Richmond Street at the corner of Bernard, just a 5 minute walk north of Western University's main gate.
